The events topic is "Werkzeugkiste". ("toolbox"). We aim that every participant creates a tool for a common toolbox. The creation-process should be documented, to allow insights into the craft and spread the knowledge.

If the documentation comes as video, drawing or foto-documentation is up to you. The documentations will will be gathered and published together for everyone accessible. In the final week of the happening there will be videoconferences in which the participants can exchange their experience about the different techniques.

With this structure it is possible for experienced blacksmiths to pass on their knowledge and we are able to learn from each other. The toolbox is afterwards available to borrow for blacksmith gatherings
